



General

Admissions to the Reception Class at Holywell Green Primary School will take place in accordance with the Calderdale Primary Admissions Policy.

Order of priority.

- 1st Priority
- a) Pupils who are in receipt of a Statement (in accordance with the Education Act 1981) where the Authority has named a particular school or unit as necessary to meet the child's needs.
 - b) Consideration will also be given to children recommended for admission by the Area Medical Officer, or the Director of Education or the Director of Social Services.
- 2nd Priority: Pupils who have a brother or sister attending the school at the time of admission.
- 3rd. Priority: Pupils living within the school's defined priority zone at the time of admission for whom there is no alternative school available within a reasonable distance of the pupil's home.
Pupils living outside the Authority's area but nearer to the school than some pupils within the priority zone and for whom travel to an alternative school would be difficult.

Where any of the above categories is oversubscribed places will be allocated on the basis of nearness to school and ease of access to other schools. Nearness to school will be determined by safe walking distance.
